Our mission is to **encourage ambitious climate action** in the G20 countries. Being responsible for approximately 75% of global GHG emissions, G20 economies play a decisive role in reaching the goals of the Paris Agreement.



Our **global partnership** brings together experts from research organisations and NGOs in the majority of the G20 countries, who together examine climate action.



Around 100 indicators in the areas of **adaptation**, **mitigation**, and **finance** enhance transparency and compare G20 countries to stimulate a race to the top in ambitious climate action.


